Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1/8 Yd - Red Plaid (Y1205-4)
- 1/8 Yd - Red Leaf (Y1210-4)
- 1/8 Yd - Dk Green Snowflake (Y1207-22)
- 1/8 Yd - Lt Olive Leaf (Y1210-23)
- 1/4 Yd - Red Snowflake (Y1207-4)
- 7/8 Yd - Olive Plaid (Y1205-24)
- 1 FQ - Red Gift (Y1206-4)
- 1 FQ - Olive Gift (Y1206-24)
- 1 FQ - Cream Ornament (Y1209-2)
- 1 FQ - Lt Olive Ornament (Y1209-23)
- 1 FQ - Red Tossed Clothing (Y1208-4)
- 1 FQ - Dk Green Tossed Clothing (Y1208-22)
- 1/8 Yd - Lt Gray Impressions Flora (Y1062-5)
- 1 1/2 Yds - Cream Snowflake (Y1207-2)
- 7/8 Yd - Cream Leaf (Y1210-2)
- 1 1/8 Yds - Lt Olive Tossed Clothing (Y1208-23)
- 3 1/2 Yds - Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Red Plaid, Red Leaf, Dk Green Snowflake, Lt Olive Leaf, cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles

From the Red Snowflake cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
- 20 - 2 1/2" squares (Cornerstones)

From the Olive Plaid cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 6" squares (Border)
- 7 - 2 1/2" WOF strips (Binding)

From the Red Gift, Red Tossed Clothing, and Cream Ornament, cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (see photo)

From the Olive Gift, Lt Olive Ornament, and Dk Green Tossed Clothing cut:

- 2 - 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (see photo)

From the Lt Gray Impressions Flora cut:

- 12 - 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles

From the Cream Snowflake cut:

- 12 - 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles
- 24 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
- 24 - 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
- 12 - 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles
- 48 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Cream Leaf cut:

- 31 - 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles (Sashing)

From the Lt Olive Tossed Clothing cut:

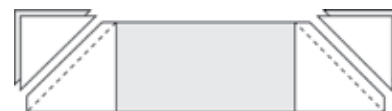
- 6 - 6" WOF strips (Border)

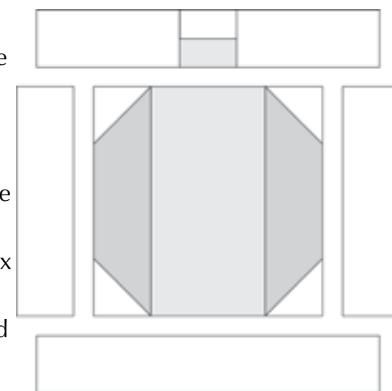
Directions

Ornament Blocks - Finished Size 12 1/2" square with seam allowances

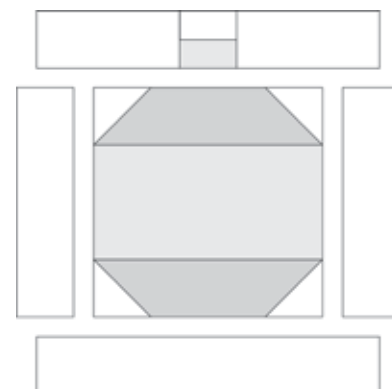
1. With a pencil, mark the diagonal on the wrong side of each 2 1/2" Cream Snowflake square.
2. With right sides facing each other, place a 2 1/2" Cream Snowflake square at each end of a 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Red Snowflake rectangle.
3. Sew on the diagonal pencil lines and trim away the corners, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 1)
4. Repeat Steps 1 - 3 on a second 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Red Snowflake rectangle.
5. Sew a Snowflake Unit to each side of a 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Red Tossed Clothing rectangle to make the ornament unit.
6. Sew a 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Cream Snowflake rectangle to each side of the ornament unit.
7. Sew a 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" Gray Impressions rectangle to a 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" Cream Snowflake rectangle to make the hanging unit.
8. Sew a 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Cream Snowflake rectangle to each end of the hanging unit.
9. Sew the hanging unit to the top of the ornament unit.
10. Sew a 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Cream Snowflake rectangle to the bottom of the ornament unit to complete the block.
11. Make 2 of each block, turning the center of the Red Ornament units vertically (Diagram 2) & the center of the Olive Ornament units horizontally (Diagram 3):
 Red Tossed Clothing + Red Snowflake
 Cream Ornament + Red Plaid
 Red Gift + Red Leaf
 Olive Gift + Dk Olive Plaid
 Lt Olive Ornament + Lt Olive Leaf
 Dk Green Tossed Clothing + Dk Green Snowflake

Putting it Together

1. Referring to the picture on the front, lay out the ornament blocks, the 2 1/2" Red Snowflake cornerstones, & the 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Cream Leaf sashing into rows.
2. Sew the blocks, sashing & cornerstones together in each row, alternately pressing the seams in each row left or right.
3. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Add the Border

1. Sew 3 of the 6" Lt Olive Tossed WOF strips together and cut into 2 - 6" x 58 1/2" rectangles and sew to each side of the quilt.
2. Sew the remaining 3 - 6" Lt Olive Tossed WOF strips together and cut into 2 - 6" x 44 1/2" rectangles.
3. Sew a 6" Olive Plaid square to each end of the border rectangles and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Finish the Quilt

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
2. Make the binding.
3. Apply the binding to the quilt.
