Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1. 3/4 yard - Pink (K2666-42)
 2. 3/4 yard - Lt. Yellow (K2666-8)
 3. 1 1/2 yard - Dk. Purple (K2666-28)
 4. 1 1/2 yard - Dk. Wine (K2666-49)
(includes binding)
 5. 3/8 yard - Orange (K2666-36)
 6. 3/8 yard - Lt. Taupe (K2666-61)
 7. 3/4 yard - Brick (K2666-51)
 8. 3/4 yard - Dk. Coral (K2666-40)
- 4 yards backing of your choice
(Suggested: AMB-117, Lt. Indigo)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Pink Ombre cut:

- 6 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 1)

From the Lt. Yellow Ombre cut:

- 6 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 2)

From the Dk. Purple Ombre cut:

- 3 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 3)
- 7 - 4 1/2" WOF strips
(Outer Border)

From the Dk. Wine Ombre cut:

- 3 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 4)
- 6 - 1 1/2" WOF strips
(Inner Border)
- 7 - 2 1/2" WOF strips (Binding)

From the Orange Ombre cut:

- 3 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 5)

From the Lt. Taupe Ombre cut:

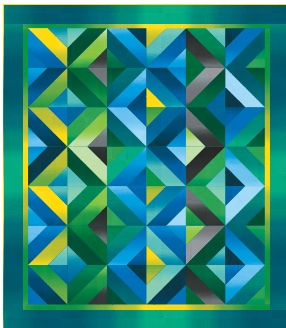
- 3 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 6)

From the Brick Ombre cut:

- 6 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 7)

From the Dk. Coral Ombre cut:

- 6 - 3 1/2" WOF strips (Fabric 8)



Alternate Blue/Green Version

1. 1/4 yard - Blue (K2666-33)
2. 3/4 yard - Blue/Dk Blue (K2666-31)
3. 1 1/2 yard - Blue/Aqua (K2666-34)
4. 1 1/2 yard - Green/Yellow (K2666-23)
(includes binding)
5. 3/8 yard - Gray/Black (K2666-7)
6. 3/8 yard - Light Green (K2666-24)
7. 3/4 yard - Green (K2666-21)
8. 3/4 yard - Green/Blue (K2666-22)

Directions

String Blocks - Measured Size 9" square (unfinished size)

1. With right sides facing each other, sew together the following strips:

Unit A - Fabric 1 + Fabric 2

Unit B - Fabric 3 + Fabric 4

Unit C - Fabric 5 + Fabric 6

Unit D - Fabric 7 + Fabric 8

2. Using the Companion Angle or similar ruler, cut the following number of triangles from each Unit: (see Diagram 1) Cut half of the Units starting with Fabric 1 at the bottom and half with Fabric 2 at the bottom.

Unit A - 14 + 14(r)

Unit B - 7 + 7(r)

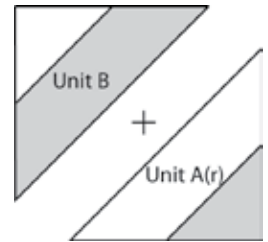
Unit C - 7 + 7(r)

Unit D - 14 + 14(r)

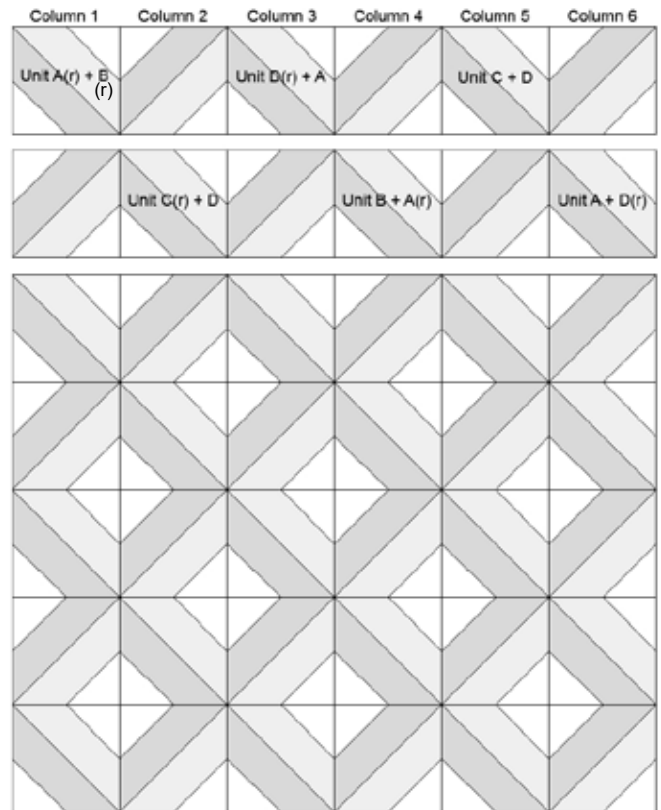
3. Sew together the following triangles to create the blocks: (see Diagram 2)
Units A(r) + B(r) = Column 1 blocks; Units B + A(r) = Column 4 blocks
Units C(r) + D = Column 2 blocks; Units C + D = Column 5 blocks
Units D(r) + A = Column 3 blocks; Units A + D(r) = Column 6 blocks

Putting it Together

1. Referring to the Layout Diagram, lay out the blocks into rows.
2. Sew the blocks together in each row, alternately pressing the seams in each row left or right.
3. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

1. Sew the 1 1/2" Inner Border strips together and cut into 2 - 1 1/2" x 60" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 53 1/2" strips.
2. Sew the 1 1/2" x 60" strips to the sides of the quilt.
3. Sew the 1 1/2" x 53 1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt
4. Sew the 4 1/2" Outer Border strips together and cut into 4 - 4 1/2" x 62" strips.
5. Sew two of the 4 1/2" x 62" strips to the sides of the quilt.
6. Sew the other two 4 1/2" x 62" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
