Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 panel - Mythical Jungle (Y2134-3M)
- 7/8 Yard - Black Animals (Y2137-3M)
- 1/3 Yard - Lime Geo (Y2133-17)
- 1/3 Yard - White Elephants (Y2139-2M)
- 1/4 Yard - Dk Aqua Geo (Y2133-34)
- 5/8 Yard - Purple Geo (Y2133-37)
- 1/4 Yard - Orange Geo (Y2133-36)
- 3/8 Yard - Packed Animals (Y2132-56M)
- 1/2 Yard - Binding - Black LB Basic Triangles (Y0841-3M)
- 3 Yards - Backing of your choice
- Suggested: Dark Aqua Animals (Y2137-34M)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

From the Black Animals cut:

- 2 - 8 7/8" squares
- 2 - 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips
- 2 - 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips

From the Lime Geo cut:

- 15 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the White Elephants cut:

- 2 - 8 7/8" squares

From the Dk Aqua Geo cut:

- 16 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the Purple Geo cut:

- 4 - 3 1/2" x WOF strips
- 15 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the Orange Geo cut:

- 16 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

From the Packed Animals cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips
- 2 - 2 1/2" x 28 1/2" strips

From the Black LB Basic Triangles cut:

- 5 - 2 1/4" x WOF binding strips

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. Clothworks is not responsible for printing errors.

Assemble the Panel Center

1. Trim the Mythical Jungle panel to 21 1/2" x 23 1/2" (leaving at least 1/4" seam allowance outside the panel images.)
2. Sew a 3 1/2" Purple Tonal strip to each long edge of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip (Fig. 1).

3. Sew a 3 1/2" Purple Tonal strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip.
4. Trim the panel, with borders added, to measure 26 1/2" x 28 1/2".

Assemble the Piano Key Borders

1. Referring to the quilt photo for placement, sew sixteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles together as shown in the cover photo to make a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" border strip; press in one direction. Sew a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" Black Animals rectangle along the long edge; press toward the Black. Repeat to make to a total of two side border strips. If the piano key strip is not the same length as the black animals strip, adjust the piano key strip to fit.
2. Following the same process, make the top and bottom border strips by sewing fifteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles together to make a total of two 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" border strips. Press seams all in one direction. Sew a 4 1/2" x 30 1/2" Black Animals rectangle along the long edge of each border strip; press toward the Black. If the piano key strip is not the same length as the Black Animals strip, adjust the piano key strip to fit.

Assemble the Corner Blocks

1. Pair a 8 7/8" Black Animals square right sides together with a White Elephants 8 7/8" square. Mark a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong side of the Black Animals square (Fig. 2).

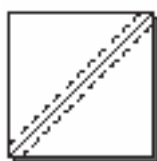

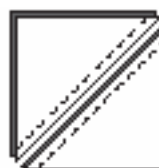

2. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the line and cut apart on the marked line (Fig. 3). Press open carefully to make a half square triangle (Fig. 4). Trim to 8 1/2" square.
3. Repeat to make a total of four half-square triangle corner blocks

Assemble the Quilt

1. Sew a 2 1/2" x 28 1/2" Packed Animals strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center; press towards the Packed Animals. Sew a 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" Packed Animals strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press toward the Packed Animals.
2. Sew a 32 1/2" long Piano Key border strip the left and right sides of the quilt center; press toward the border.
3. Referring to the quilt photo for placement, sew a corner block to both ends of the 30 1/2" long Piano Key border strips. Sew these border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press toward the border.
4. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and baste. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting from around the borders and square the corners. Add the binding to the quilt.
