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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1 Panel Main Print (Y0560-33)
1/4 yd Yellow Tonal (Y0562-9)
1/4 yd Blue Tonal (Y0562-30)
1/4 yd Pink Star (Y0564-42)
3/8 yd Green Animal (Y0563-20)
3/8 yd Blue Animal (Y0563-30)
3/8 yd Pink Animal (Y0563-42)
5/8 yd Stripe (Y0561-33)
5/8 yd Cream Star (Y0564-2)
5/8 yd Aqua Star (Y0564-33)
includes binding
2-1/4 yds Backing of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Main Print fussy cut:

1 – Panel 20-1/2" x 20-1/2" square

From the Stripe cut:

5 – 3-1/2" x WOF strips

From the Yellow Tonal cut:

2 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips, crosscut
into 32 – 2-1/2" squares

From the Blue Tonal cut:

2 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips, crosscut
into 32 – 2-1/2" squares

From the Green Animal cut:

8 – 5-1/2" squares

From the Blue Animal cut:

8 – 5-1/2" squares

From the Pink Animal cut:

8 – 5-1/2" squares

From the Cream Star cut:

2 – 3" x 20-1/2" vertical borders
2 – 3" x 25-1/2" horizontal borders
2 – 2" x 35-1/2" vertical borders
2 – 2" x 38-1/2" horizontal borders

From the Aqua Star cut:

2 – 2" x 38-1/2" vertical borders
2 – 2" x 41-1/2" horizontal borders
5 – 2-1/4" x WOF strips (binding)

From the Pink Star cut:

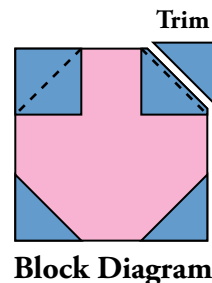
2 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips, crosscut
into 32 – 2-1/2" squares

Directions

Quilt Assembly

1. Sew the vertical Cream Star short border strips to opposite sides of the center panel. Sew the matching short horizontal strips to the top and bottom of the center panel.
2. Pair the snowball blocks as follows: (1) Pink Animal 5-1/2" square with (4) Blue 2-1/2" squares, (1) Green Animal with (4) Pink 2-1/2" squares and (1) Blue Animal 5-1/2" square with (4) Yellow 2-1/2" squares. Make (8) sets in each color combination.
3. Position a 2-1/2" square in each corner of a 5-1/2" square. Sew through the small square on a diagonal line from corner to corner. Trim away excess fabric and fold triangle out. Repeat for each corner to complete a snowball block. Make 8 blocks in each color combination. (See Block Diagram)
4. Refer to the color photograph of the quilt to position the Snowball blocks into borders. There are (2) side borders with (5) blocks each. Make the borders and join them to opposite sides of the quilt center. There are (7) blocks in the top and bottom borders. Make the borders and join them to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
5. Sew the Cream Star borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the Cream Star horizontal star borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
6. Sew the Aqua Star borders in the same manner as the borders in step 5.
7. Sew Stripe border strips together end-to-end. Recut into (4) borders 52" long. Center a border strip to one side of the quilt top. Sew border in place stopping 1/4" from end of aqua borders at each end. Repeat for remaining 3 sides. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric from corners.
8. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt layers together.
9. Sew the binding together end-to-end. Fold lengthwise and press fold line. Align raw edge of binding to raw edge of quilt top. Stitch in place. Turn folded edge to back and stitch in place.
