Fabric by Clothworks

Quilt Design by Cyndi Walker 56" x 64"

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide *unwashed* fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

1-1/4 yds	Black (Y0890-3) inc binding
5/8 yd	Green (Y0890-18)
1-5/8 yds	Cream (Y0890-2)
3/8 yd	Yellow (Y0890-8)
3/8 yd	Orange (Y0890-37)
3/8 yd	Purple (Y0890-26)
3/8 yd	White (Y0890-1)
1/4 yd	Purple Stripe (Y0774-27)
1/4 yd	Green Stripe (Y0774-19)
1/4 yd	Purple Bushes (Y0777-26)
1/4 yd	Green Bushes (Y0777-18)
3/8 yd	Orange Bushes (Y0777-35)
4 yds	Backing of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From Black cut:

15 – 5-1/4" squares, cut diagonally twice
11 – 4-1/2" squares

7 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips -binding

From Green cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once
4 – 4-1/2" squares

5 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sewn and trimmed to:

2 – 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips

2 – 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips

From Cream cut:

15 – 5-1/4" squares, cut diagonally twice

5 – 4-1/2" squares

30 – 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

30 – 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

2 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips, recut into:

30 – 1-1/2" squares

5 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sewn and trimmed to:

2 – 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips

2 – 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips

From Yellow cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

6 – 4-1/2" squares

From Orange cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

4 – 4-1/2" squares

2 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips, recut into:

30 – 1-1/2" squares

From Purple cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

5 – 4-1/2" squares

From White cut:

10 – 4-1/2" squares

From Purple Stripe cut:

3 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips, recut into:

15 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

15 – 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles

From Green Stripe cut:

5 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips, recut into:

15 – 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

15 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

From Purple Bushes cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

4 – 4-1/2" squares

From Green Bushes cut:

4 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

From Orange Bushes cut:

6 – 4-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once

7 – 4-1/2" squares

Windmill Blocks

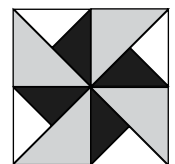
1. Sew together one Black triangle and one Cream triangle to make a half-triangle unit (fig 1). Press the seam allowance toward the Black triangle. Repeat to make a total of 60 Black and Cream triangle units.
2. Sew a Green triangle to a unit from step 1 along the diagonal side (fig 2). Press the seam allowance toward the Green triangle to complete the windmill unit.
3. Repeat this process to make sixty windmill units in the following colors: eight Green, eight Purple, twelve Orange Bushes, eight Orange, eight Green Bushes, eight Purple Bushes, and eight Yellow.
4. Referring to the Windmill Block Assembly Diagram lay out four Green windmill units. Sew together the pieces in each row, pressing the seam allowances in opposite directions for each row. Join the rows together to complete the block. It should measure 8-1/2" square.
5. Repeat to make a total of fifteen windmill blocks in these colors; two Green, two Purple, three Orange Bushes, two Orange, two Green Bushes, two Purple Bushes and two Yellow.

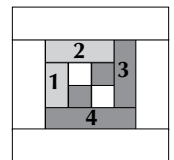

Log Cabin Blocks

1. Sew two Orange and two Cream 1-1/2" squares into a four-patch unit. Working in a clockwise direction, starting with the left edge, add rectangles to the unit in the following order: 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Purple Stripe rectangle, 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" Purple Stripe rectangle, 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" Green Stripe rectangle, and 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Green Stripe rectangle. As you add each rectangle, press the seam allowance toward the rectangle.
2. Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Cream rectangle to the left and right sides of the log cabin unit. Press the seam allowances toward the Cream rectangles. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Cream rectangle to the top and bottom edges of the log cabin unit to complete the log cabin block. Press the seam allowances toward the Cream rectangles. It should measure 8-1/2" square.
3. Repeat to make a total of fifteen log cabin blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1. Referring to quilt photo for layout, assemble windmill and log cabin blocks to make quilt center.
2. Sew a 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" Cream strip to the long edges of the quilt center. Sew the remaining Cream strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center.
3. Sew a 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" Green strip to the long edges of the quilt center. Sew the remaining Green strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center.
4. Referring to the quilt photo for layout, join fourteen 4-1/2" blocks in assorted colors end to end to make four outer border strips, including a Green 4-1/2" square at each end of two of the strips. Sew an outer border strip (without the Green squares) to the side edges of the quilt center. Sew the remaining two (with Green squares) to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
5. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
